

The duration of Hon. secretary should be reduced to one year & duration of treasurer should be reduced to one year

Members deliberated extensively on this topic issue. Including time taken for change in signatories in bank takes time and there is added change in GST address. GBM decided **to continue existing format.**

d. Dr Suresh Kagalkarreddy -

Equal Representation in KUA council from North Karnataka zone with alternating year representation in council from south and north zone.

He noted that north Karnataka members were not much involved in the society and need of reservation of council post in north Karnataka. If it continues like this, they may plant to have a separate society for north zone members.

This raised lot of debate in the hall. Dr G K Venkatesh expressed, why this division between North and south Karnataka? And not to bring Politics in the society. He mentioned that even first KUA meeting was held at Shivamogga in 1996 and there were no questions or issues of such division since inception. There is Compulsory Distribution of Academic activities throughout the all zones of Karnataka but not the council post

Dr Amruth Raj Gowda said that they had a opinion like this of recently since the number of members increased in each zone and supports for north zone activities.

Dr Anant J Kamath listening to the grievances of the north zone members asked GBM to consider the opinion.

Dr Avinash Odugowder from Gadag asked for equal representation of members for council across the state.

Dr Gajanan Bhat said the grievances of north Karnataka is true and needs to be addressed by GBM.

Dr S B Patil urged GBM to decide about the Zonal matter at the earliest.

Dr Srivatsa, opined this issue can be solved like this, since KUA is parent body, one representation from each zonal bodies like each one from BUS, MYSOGUS, BUNS etc



Dr Chandrashekar Rao and Dr. Gajanan bhat suggested can we keep one council member each from 4 revenue divisions of Karnataka.

Dr G K Venkatesh opined that opportunity was given to Dr Dhanyakumar of Shivamogga to host first KUA conference in 1996, even though there were more members from Bangalore at that time compared to other zones, He urged the GBM please do not bring politics here, we KUA members are all one and we have to work together for the betterment of the society and urged the GBM to proceed without any conclusion.

Dr Nischith D Souza, President KUA suggested to deliberating these options again in council and also taking opinion from all members through email correspondence and based on that to decide in next GBM.

Agenda 10: Venue for KUACON 2023 and KUACON 2024

a. Congratulated to Shivamogga team to host 28th KUACON 2023

b. Dr. Nagabhushan M, from INU, Bangalore had sent a proposal to KUA secretary to host 29th KUACON 2024 at Bangalore

President informed the proposal letter to come through recommendation of local society at the earliest, as was decided during the GBM 3 years ago. In this case, from Dr Sanjay R P, BUS Secretary has to get this passed in BUS council meeting and then send the proposal to secretary KUA.

In the floor, request was made by Hubballi and Gadag team to Host 29th KUACON 2024. The president mentioned no official correspondence has been received from them and informed the team to get the approval letter from local society / zonal area and to send it to Hon. secretary email within 1 month from now and the council will take final decision.

c. Dr Prakash K Prabhu expressed that MYSOGUS will host 30th KUACON 2025 at Mysore. He will request Mysogus secretary to do the needful. This was supported By Dr Amruthraj Gowda and Dr Narendra JB at GBM

Agenda 11: Any other matter with permission of chair

There was proposal to increase the Corpus for live operative workshop which is conducted by MYSOGUS from 10,000 Rs to 25,000 rupees. Dr. Kumar Prabhu mentioned that total expenditure that can be spent for all the KUA programs in total is 50,000 Rs per year as per earlier GBM approval. This amount is given by President KUA to the local organizers at the time of inauguration function. The GBM agreed to increase the amount for live workshop.
